Once considered a functional space, the bathroom has become an inspirational, indulgent area reminiscent of luxury boutique hotel suites, intended for serious rest and relaxation. Designing bathrooms is about creating a place that you want to spend time in, not just for washing.

Modular furniture originally found in the kitchen is now being incorporated into the bathroom to keep all of our toiletries out of sight. This essential component is accentuated by high-gloss coloured lacquers found in ranges such as Sentique and Central Line collections

from Villeroy & Boch. Bold colours such as black are being incorporated into the bathroom, offering an alternative look to warm and directional rich wood grains. Darker wood finishes such as Amazakoue or Macassar from the Memento and Central Line ranges create a more dramatic effect.
