HOW TO MAKE IT WORK

Sugar Cube sideboard H79xW168xD49cm, £4,350, Knowles & Christou. **Art Deco screen**, H175xW43cm each panel, £145 per panel plus 8m of fabric for three panels. The Screen Gallery. **Screen in** Lucent Silver ED85062-905, viscose/linen/polyester mix, 133cm wide, £75m, Threads at GP&J Baker. **Perspex-framed artwork**, Silver Dot, 99x66cm, £3,000, Oi Nuen Sprunt at Northcote Gallery. **Glass Blob lamp** GLB-31 in Amethyst, H42.5cm, £1,095; **shade** in Prune Silk, diam46cm, £143.35; both Porta Romana. **Botanical tray**, £245, Katharine Pooley. **Wine glasses**, £39 each, Designers Guild. **Cream vase**, £20; **Gunmetal wrapping paper**, £2.50 roll; **gift tags**, 45p each; **pink damask foil wrap**, £2.75 sheet; all Paperchase. **Red wire-edged ribbon**, £2.35m; **spotty ribbon**, £2.25m; **red satin ribbon**, 95p m; all VV Rouleaux.

■ Soft, sumptuous fabrics work with patterned wallpaper, while buttoned cushions add a tailored touch.

■ An interesting sideboard creates a focal point in the room, and provides a surface on which to place lighting.

■ Accessories in a combination of berry hues add depth to the palette while lifting the overall scheme.

■ Full-length curtains with a tailored pelmet add subtle luxury, finished with blinds in a contrasting colour.

■ Select delicate whites for the background and layer with pieces in deeper shades of off-white and grey for a classic look.

■ Add bold accents of vibrant colour with rugs in contemporary patterns and lighting in organic shapes.

■ Coordinate Christmas decorations and flowers to work in harmony with your existing colour scheme.

■ A console table with symmetrical lamps looks sleek and smart while offering an extra surface for flowers.

■ Select dinnerware with a sheen to carry the look of the pearlescent wallpaper to the table.

■ Plant a small tabletop Christmas tree in a container that coordinates with your tree decorations.

■ Add small simple cushions in matching fabrics to the dining chairs for extra comfort.
